Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence from eating meat for Catholics. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Those from age 14 onwards and are asked to abstain from meat.
