## **Parking and Seating Arrangements:**

Because we are expecting large numbers, we have had to carefully plan ahead to facilitate visitors from outside the parish.

First can we ask that those able-bodied, who live within walking distance of St Nicholas' Church, <u>not</u> to take their car. For those Parishioners who need to arrive by car, can they make arrangements to carshare and to find a parking space away from the church leaving themselves enough time to walk from their parking spot to the Church. E.g. using the public carparks down at the Marina or beside the play-park at Greenfield steps or to make their own arrangements to park in the driveways or laneways of people they know.

On the evening of Monday 13<sup>th</sup> from 5pm onwards, there will be the opportunity to park in the carpark of St Nicholas' Primary school and to avail of a **Down Community Shuttle Bus Service** up to the Church in time for the evening Mass.

Covered seating will be available with loudspeakers under Gazebo's placed alongside the Church.

There will be a 'drop-off point' in the Church grounds for disabled people who, accompanied by loved-ones, will be given priority to venerate the relic. School children along with disabled will be given priority at the 10.00am Mass. Seats at the evening Mass will be reserved only for disabled people and choir members.
